## Code of Conduct

### Guidelines for the good of campers, staff and facilities:

- Smoking, gambling, drugs and alcohol are prohibited at camp.
- Please do not bring knives and/or electronic entertainment systems to camp.
- Attendance is expected at all programmed activities.
- Out of bounds: maintenance and staff areas, kitchen and cabins of the opposite sex.
- Do not leave campgrounds without prior arrangement with camp director.
- Curfew times are to be respected.
- Modest clothing and swimwear (girls, one piece or T-shirt over, no topless; guys, modest loose-fitting swimshorts) are to be worn.
- Any vandalism to the property will be charged to the camper at replacement cost.
- Do not bring pets or motor boats to camp.

## Registration Information & Camp Policies

### Please read carefully

- It is a policy of Beacon that no camper should be deprived of coming to camp because of lack of funds (children camps only). If you need help, send in as much as you can with a note attached. You have friends at camp who will help with fees as needed. If you wish to send an extra gift to defray costs so we can help others get to camp, please issue a separate cheque to Beacon and designate it "sponsorship gift".
- Ages refer to CALENDAR YEAR. Please apply ONLY FOR THE CAMP YOU ARE ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND. We will not accept any other applications. Check the calendar years listed to the left of this column to see which camp you can attend.
- Parents or guardians should fill out the registration forms for younger campers. Please print CLEARLY.
- We require the form to be filled out COMPLETELY and SIGNED. A parent / guardian's signature is required for all campers under 18 years of age. In addition, we want campers Co-ed age and older to read and sign so they clearly understand the code of conduct.
- Registrations are accepted in the order they are received when accompanied by a payment or acceptable alternate arrangements. One cheque is acceptable for several registrations. Make cheque/s payable to Beacon Bible Camp.
- On summer camp cancellations received later than 20 days prior to the camp session, Beacon reserves the right to retain the registration fee to cover expenses. Camp registrations are non-transferable.
- Items left behind by campers will be held at Beacon for three weeks, after which they will be donated to the Salvation Army.
- Beacon Bible Camp does not send confirmation of camper registration for weekend sessions. If confirmation is required, call the camp office.
- The information provided on our registration forms is used for Beacon Bible Camp ("BBC") purposes only. This includes registration packages for upcoming sessions, information for BBC events and projects, and for camper follow-up. BBC does not share privacy information with third party vendors for the purposes of solicitation. If you have any questions concerning BBC and privacy please contact the camp office.

## Conditions of Registration

- The acceptance by the camp trustees of this application, and the signature of the parent or guardian on this application shall give the camp administration the right to arrange for any special services or other requirements necessary in the best interest of the applicant and shall give the camp administration the right to obtain or approve any medical attention necessary for the applicant camper's welfare and good health and the parent or guardian hereby agrees to pay for all such services as may be required.
- While every precaution shall be taken to ensure the good welfare and protection of the applicant camper, Beacon Bible Camp, its trustees and staff members are hereby released from any and all liability in the event of any accident or misfortune that may occur to the applicant camper.
- The camp director reserves the right to dismiss a camper who in his/her opinion is jeopardizing the safety and/or rights of others, or has rejected the reasonable controls of camp.
